

## IMPORTANT MESSAGE REGARDING (E.S.A.) ELECTRICAL SAFETY AUTHORITY

The Ontario Electrical Safety Code defines the standards for safe electrical products and installations in Ontario, and when followed protects the public. This Code requires that all electrical connections and electrical equipment be approved for use. All electrical connections and equipment, including equipment on display and/or offered for sale must bear a recognized certification marking and/or a recognized field evaluation agency marking as outlined below.

**Note to Vendors powered by a generator:** Concessionaires who are supplied power by World's Finest Show's generator are responsible for providing approved equipment from their booth or concession to the generator power box and must have a minimum 10 gauge cord to plug into a 30 Amp. 120/250-Volt twist lock receptacle.
