Student Art Competition – Rules & Entry Form

This competition sponsored by **Norfolk ArtsCo** is open to all elementary and secondary school students in **Norfolk County**. The winning entries will be on exhibit during the **Norfolk County Wildlife Festival & Adventure Show** at The Aud in Simcoe, **March 13th and 14th 2010**.

The work will be judged by well-known Norfolk County artists, and prizes will be awarded for works in the following:

CATEGORIES:

- Grades 1 to 3
- Grades 4 to 6
- Grades 7 to 8
- Grades 9 to 12

PRIZES AWARDED:

- 1st Prize - \$75.00
- 2nd Prize - \$50.00
- 3rd Prize - \$25.00

Honourable Mentions awarded if deemed appropriate by judges.

♦All winners, including Honourable Mentions, will receive **FREE** family passes to the **Norfolk County Wildlife Festival & Adventure Show**, which can be picked up at the **Norfolk County Fair office** prior to the event or at the Festival either day.

ARTWORK:

Two-dimensional artwork in any medium will be accepted (**excluding** photography and three dimensional sculptures). **Work must be original (Definition: Any artwork produced by the artist, is the idea of the artist, and is not taken directly from the work of other artists or art kits.)** Work shall be no larger than 18" x 24". **Framed pieces must be ready to hang.**

THEME:

Artwork must be **wildlife or nature related**.

A **maximum of two pieces** will be accepted from each entrant.

The artist's name, phone number and name of school must be attached to the back of the artwork.

CONTEST DEADLINE:

Artwork **AND** Entry Form (see next page) must be dropped off at the Norfolk County Fair Office on or before **Wednesday, March 3, 2010**. Offices hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Thursday and 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Friday. Only the winners will be notified by phone before **Saturday, March 6th**. Those works of art **not accepted** must be picked up from the Fair Office no later than **Friday, March 12th**. (The Norfolk County Fair Office is located at 172 South Drive, in the Norfolk County fairgrounds, in Simcoe.) Works displayed at the Wildlife Show must be picked up after the show on **Sunday, March 14th**, 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
